

### Victorian Default Offer 2024-25 final decision released

We released our final decision on the Victorian Default Offer electricity price, locking in lower prices for consumers and small businesses.

From 1 July 2024, the average rate Victorian Default Offer customers pay for their electricity will reduce by around \$100 (or 6 per cent) for residential customers and around \$260 (or 7 per cent) for small business customers.

We heard strong feedback from stakeholders that cost-of-living pressures continue to make it difficult for many in our community. Affordability and consumer protections remain a key focus for the commission.

## 'Cold call' telemarketing ban commences

A ban on 'cold-call' telemarketing under the Victorian Energy Upgrades (VEU) program took effect on 1 May 2024, with doorknocking to be banned from 1 August 2024.

The bans will protect consumers from unwanted marketing phone calls and visits about the VEU program, empowering consumers to choose whether they want to be contacted for marketing purposes.

Under the bans, businesses must obtain consent from consumers before telephoning or visiting them to market energy efficient upgrades, products and services under the VEU program.

# Powercor Australia Limited - licence application


We are reviewing an application from Powercor Australia Limited for an electricity transmission licence in Victoria.

### New code of practice for gas distributors to apply from 1 October 2024

We released our final decision on the <u>Gas Distribution Code of Practice</u>. The new code will take effect on 1 October 2024 and provides a fair and clear framework for gas network customers as Victoria transitions to net-zero emissions.

Importantly, the new code removes inefficient incentives for new gas connections.

From 1 January 2025, customers who may seek to establish a new gas connection will pay up-front installation costs for new gas connections, consistent with the current practice for new electricity and water connections.
