

## Exclusion for Guaranteed Service Level payments, Jemena Electricity Network – Loss of supply, 25 May 2022

Guaranteed service level payment exclusion for an outage at the Keilor Terminal Station on 25 May 2022

Jemena Electricity Network (Victoria) Ltd (Jemena) applied to the commission on 4 July 2022 seeking exclusion from making supply restoration payments and low reliability payments (guaranteed service level payments), related to an event on 25 May 2022 at the Keilor Terminal Station (the Keilor Terminal Station power outage event).

On 9 September 2022, the Essential Services Commission granted an exclusion to Jemena from making guaranteed service level payments relating to the Keilor Terminal Station power outage event.

Under clause 6.3.4(b) of the Electricity Distribution Code of Practice (version 14), distributors can be excluded from making guaranteed service level payments for a power outage if it was caused by a failure of shared transmission network.

After reviewing the information Jemena provided, the commission is satisfied that Jemena qualifies to be granted an exclusion from the obligation to make guaranteed service level payments in relation to the Keilor Terminal Station power outage event.

The commission is satisfied that the outage on 25 May 2022 was caused by the failure of shared transmission network related to commissioning works at the Keilor Terminal Station.
