Question

2. We note there are changes in council's forecasts in the income statements, balance sheets and capital works statements between the 2017-18 budget, budget baseline information template and the 2018-19 budget. Could council please provide a breakdown of the major factors or projects that have caused these changes? In particular, the changes in cash and cash equivalents in the balance sheet, and expansion and upgrade capital works in the capital works statement

Monash's Response

The changes in Council's Capital Works program are due to a re-phasing of two major projects as well as recognising projects that will now be completed in 2018/19 and therefore will Carry Forward funds from 2017/18. As the changes in two major projects were not approved by Council until the 27 March meeting there was not sufficient time to revise Council's application to the ESC to take these into account.

From the above two tables it is clear the substantive change between Council's higher rate cap application and proposed Budget is accounted for in the two re-phased major projects and Carry Forward Funds. Both projects involve various income sources including land sales, external grants and contributions and parking reserve. This then translates into the changes in the cash and cash equivalents in the balance sheet in the proposed Budget.

Oakleigh Recreation Centre & Waverley Gymnastics Redevelopment

The Oakleigh Recreation Centre & Waverley Gymnastics Redevelopment is a \$23M project involving the relocation of Waverley Gymnastics to the Oakleigh Recreation Centre and the redevelopment of the Oakleigh Recreation Centre's indoor Basketball Courts.

This is a complex project that involves Federal and State Government Funding, contributions from the Waverley Gymnastics club and the bringing together of two tennis clubs at a new site. Finalising agreements with all parties has taken longer than originally anticipated and shifted deign and early construction from 2017/18 out by 12 months.

Montclair Car Park

Montclair Car Park is a \$46M multi-story car park development in Glen Waverley, originally intended to start construction in 2018/19. An alternative proposal was investigated by Council (Central Car Park) and this led to a delay in undertaking the design of the Montclair Car Park.

Council considered Glen Waverley Central Car Park as a Confidential item (9.1) at the 27 March 2018 Council meeting and resolved to not proceed with that proposal.
