Harmonisation of the Energy Retail Code and Guidelines with the National Energy Customer Framework (NECF) – Draft Decision (Consultation Paper)

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the Harmonisation Draft Decision.

NAGA made a submission on 1 February 2013 to the ESC on the Consultation Paper that was released in December 2012. NAGA's submission focused on Guideline 13: Greenhouse gas disclosure on electricity bills.

I am concerned that the Draft Decision released in July 2013, following the consultation process and submissions (as above) does not respond to NAGA's concerns on this issue, and that the draft decision will result in reduced access to information for Victorian consumers.

As part of the harmonisation process, the Victorian government has committed to 'no reduction in key protections for Victorian consumers', and to align consumer protection arrangements with the national framework where it does not result in lower standards. NAGA believes that information on the greenhouse impacts of consumers' energy consumption as currently provided for under Guideline 13, is a key protection in accordance with State Government Policy and that this should be maintained in the final harmonised code to ensure that it does not result in lower standards for Victorians.

NAGA strongly supports the permanent retention of this disclosure on electricity bills; in future, consideration could be given to building on this information base to support improved levels of awareness of the links between greenhouse gas emissions, energy literacy and options to reduce environmental risks in the long-term interests of consumers.
